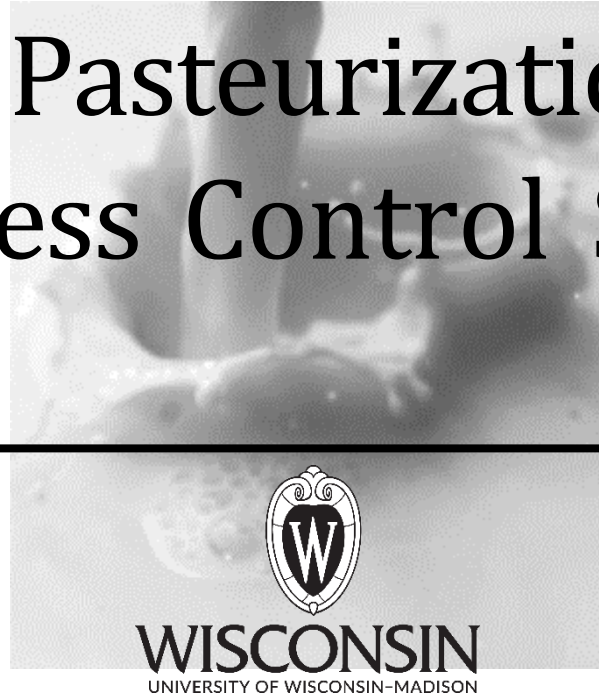


Online

Milk Pasteurization and Process Control School



Date: The design of this course is self-paced and on-demand, meaning it can be registered for and completed over several weeks. However, access to the online content will be closed on October 31, 2022.

Method of Instruction: This program's content is pre-recorded and available online for each registrant. Lecture handouts and videos are presented by technical experts from regulatory and industry partners with campus faculty and staff. The exam will be administered on the UW-Madison campus, Department of Food Science, 1605 Linden Drive, Madison, WI. Once you have reviewed all content, you will need to schedule a time and date with Scott Rankin to take the written examination.

Who Should Attend: A certificate of completion is awarded for passing the examination (>80% total score) at the end of the course. Under DACTP Ag 65, the State of Wisconsin requires a certified pasteurizer operator to be present during pasteurization; this training qualifies plant personnel for this purpose

Enrollment Fees & Costs: \$299/per registrant. Enrollment fees cover tuition, lecture materials, and examination.
